

Sustainable Resource Center 2006-2007 Goals and Objectives

- Maintain a comprehensive online resource site that is a portal to sustainability for the graduate student body and campus community. Keep updated a calendar of events related to sustainability in the community and at UCLA, campus resources such as research centers and student groups, community resources such as transportation and nonprofit organizations, information about the resource center and lending library, and information about student campaigns such as UC Build Green or UC Sustainable Food Systems.
- Maintain and expand mailing list with graduate student members from diverse departments across campus, including: Computer Science, English, Electrical Engineering, Film, Math, Environmental Science, European History, Management, Architecture, and Public Policy. Through the list provide information on events, news and internship opportunities related to sustainability. Add at least 100 members.
- Manage undergraduate employees to staff the center and assist with research. Maintain Kerckhoff 160 as the Sustainable Resource Center and the lending library.
- Organize quality programming for graduate students that provide education on issues related to sustainability and opportunities for graduate students to interact and network with these speakers and other community members and leaders.
- Continue building coalitions across campus by co-hosting interdisciplinary events with student groups, research centers and academic departments.
- Work towards campus sustainability and represent graduate student interests on the Committee on Campus Sustainability and the ASUCLA Sustainability Committee. Coordinate with GSA representative on Campus committee. Report activities of both committees to GSA.
- Continue to work with Professor Corbett of the Anderson School of Management and the Institute of the Environment on developing the new interdisciplinary graduate student emphasis entitled "Leaders in Sustainability" (launched October 4th).
- Work with Green Ambassadors program on developing mentorship program.
