One of the great advantages of living in Los Angeles (and yes, there are advantages) is the availability of good, cheap, fresh food. As one of the most multicultural cities in the world, you can find just about anything in Los Angeles. Some of the best food in L.A. happens in the oddest spots: strip malls, ethnic food courts, farmer's markets, etc. Unless otherwise noted, most of these restaurants run about \$10 or under for an entrée. Many of these places only take cash so be warned.

Loteria has really good and interesting Mexican, try the birria (goat) and nopales (cactus). Kokomo Café has good diner fare. Singapore's Banana Leaf has amazing Singapore/Malaysian. Their Mee Goreng is great. Pampas Grill has great Brazilian food by weight. Moishe's has amazing Middle Eastern. Bennett's has great ice-cream. The list goes on. All the food is usually under \$10 (with the exception of the wine-bar) and you can also run around and buy your meat, poultry, seafood, veggies, produce and specialties market items in the market. There are some fabulous bakeries, butchers (who make their own sausage-Marconda's is particularly knowledgeable) and greengrocers for a fraction of the cost of what you would pay at Whole Foods or Bristol Farms (really where all the best meat and produce are).
